


PARENT'S FEEDBACK ANALYSIS






- *The particular rating on quality of Academics of the College was scored 39% Highly Satisfied, 61% Satisfied.

- 6. Laboratory attendants in Physics and Chemistry labs are required.



- 7. The Syllabus and Social awareness was rated 20% as excellent, 16% very good, 23% good and 26% average, 15% poor.




